# President's Message for NORVA News, March 2016

Everything is beginning to slide into place for the 2016 Region 3 Rally, which begins on April 27th, at The Meadow Event Park, off I-95 near Doswell, VA. Because this event will be "in our backyard," Region 3 President Matt Hackney has called upon us to assist with some of the planning and hosting. Last September, Tom Carmichael and I toured the rally site and spoke with its director and operations manager. Since then, Region 3's officers have negotiated pricing and on-site services, but there is still more to be done and volunteers are needed.

NORVA has been asked to supervise and conduct parking, along with club members from the other Virginia WBCCI units. More than



100 Airstream trailers and motor homes are pected to attend the rally which will run five davs. through Sunday morning, May 1st. Tom Carmichael is coordinating NORVA's support and seeks people to serve on the Park-

ing Committee. He needs at least ten Virginia IWBCCI volunteers and hopes five will be NORVA members. Please let him know if you are able and willing to help (call him at 804-245-1710 or e-mail: tomc@sportsimageinc.com). As a parker, you must be at the rally site on Tuesday, April 26<sup>th</sup>, the day before the rally starts, to park your rig and assist with set up. The job of parking the 100+ arriving trailers and motor homes will start around 9 a.m. on Wednesday, April 27, and last most of that day. Bring a hand-held CB if you have one

Additionally, NORVA and Virginia Unit 109 are expecting to staff a hospitality table at the rally to hand out tourism literature and answer questions. Assisting us will be representatives from the Caroline County Tourism Department.



"SITE OF REGION 3": **Doswell Virginia** is an unincorporated community in Hanover County in the Central Region of the U.S. Commonwealth of Virginia. Originally called Hanover Junction, it was located on the Virginia Central Railroad, which later became part of the Chesapeake and Ohio Railroad (C&O) at a crossing of the Richmond, Fredericksburg and Potomac Railroad, a north-south route. Both railroads are now owned by CSX Transportation, although the former Virginia Central line is leased to a short-line carrier, Buckingham Branch Railroad. The area near the Doswell train station is a popular train-watching site for railfans.

The name was changed to Doswell in the early 1890s in honor of Major Thomas Doswell (1823—90).

The first Doswell in the area was James Doswell, a captain in the American Revolution.
